**Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> September** -European day of Languages (Italian focus) – Mrs. Parker will also be making a special Italian lunch!

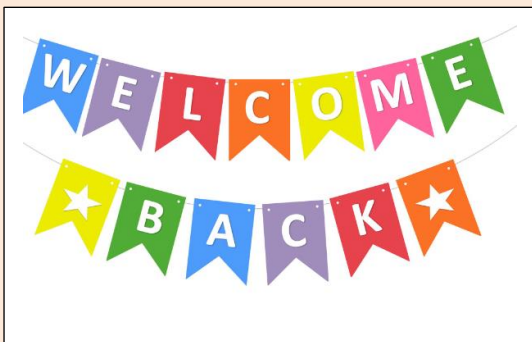
**Friday 27<sup>th</sup> September** 10-11pm – Macmillan 'Reading Cafe' Event. All parents welcome – more details will be available soon!
